Moses Anderson: Son of Niels and Amelia Augusta Pederson Anderson, was born 1 December 1870, at Moroni, Utah. He lived at Moroni with his parents until 1878 when his family moved to Vermillion, or Sigurd as it was then called. Here he lived with his family, working and taking active part in church and other civic activities, attending school, making many friends until his mother passed away, leaving a grieving family.

In 1889 he moved to Nevada, settling at Pioche, here he worked for several years, he then moved to Elko, Nevada, he worked here with the Griswold Land and Livestock Company, then later he worked with the Adam-McGoll Company in White Pine County, Nev. He also worked for the Nevada Consolidated Copper Corporation in Ruth, Nevada. He worked here for several years then later worked for the State Highway Department.

He was a member of the United Spanish War Veterans and was Pas Commander of the James R. Locket Post in Carson. He was a member of the Cherry Creek Lodge L.O.O.F. in Ely and at the time of his death was Chairman of the Ormsby Republican Central Committee.

He married Clara M. and he and his wife are the proud parents of Dr. Fred L. Anderson, a prominent Physician, and a daughter Mrs. Clair Williams of Elko, Nev.

He passed away 19 Oct 1942 at Carson, Nevada.
